PRAYERS

THE WORLD: EGYPT

- Give thanks the government has begun to implement the process of legalising churches and church-affiliated buildings in accordance with recent legislation. Pray that this process will continue, as there are many churches still waiting for licences.
- Pray that believers will trust God patiently throughout this process and continue to testify to the truth of Christ through their words and actions, showing love especially to those who are opposed to them.

MISSION PARTNERS – Hermon Living Water Ministries (HLWM), South India

- Pray for all our congregations that they grow strong in the lord and continue to proclaim the gospel despite the uncertainty resulting from the political situation and upcoming hindu festivals. Pray for all the pastors and their families.
- Many are concerned about the possible implications of the recent election for Christian-Hindu relations. Pray for God's protection for believers.
- Pray for God's provision of sufficient funds to support the proclamation of the gospel and social work programs through HLWM. Give thanks for the teaching staff and other staff who serve faithfully to maintain these programs.

- Give thanks for *Celebration of Hope*, and for the new spirit of fellowship that, by God's grace, has been engendered between the various churches within Singapore which took part. Pray that all those people who responded will be followed up effectively in local churches.
- Pray for the preparations for the forthcoming Synod meetings, to take place over the 2 days 12th – 13th July.

Pray for integrity, vision and strength for all who lead our nation, including our President Mdm Halimah Yacob and our Prime Minister Mr Lee Hsien Loong.
