

ST GEORGE'S CHURCH – ELECTORAL ROLL

St George's considers all regular attendees "members" of our church family. Yet we also encourage all our members to take a further step to register themselves on the Electoral Roll of the church, so as to become "voting members" of St George's.

What is the Church Electoral Roll?

It is your church's register of electors; of those qualified to vote at the Annual General Meeting. By enrolling you become a **voting member of this church**. As such you will have a vote at our Annual General Meeting, and you are also eligible to be nominated as a candidate for election to the PCC. There is no financial obligation attached.

Do I qualify?

To be eligible, you should be over 17 years of age and be able to subscribe to the following statements:

1. I have been baptised in a Christian church that is in communion with the Anglican Church.
2. I am at present a *communicant member* of the Anglican Church and do not belong to any religious body which is not in communion with it.
3. I worship regularly at **St. George's Church** in which I am applying for registration.
4. So far as I am aware my name is not included in any other Electoral Roll in this Diocese.

A 'communicant member' means a person who has received Communion according to the use of the Anglican Church or of a Church in communion with it at least three times within the twelve months preceding the signing of the above Application Form.

FAQ

• How do I enrol?

Pick up the "**Application for Enrolment on Church Electoral Roll**" form from the church office. Please check first for your name on the updated Electoral Roll posted on the board in the Courtyard.

• How can I transfer my membership to this parish?

If you are from another Anglican Church in Singapore, fill in 2 copies of the "Diocese of Singapore: Membership Transfer" form (yellow in colour); obtainable at the Church Office. Hand in the completed form to your church for them to arrange the transfer.

If you are from another denomination within Singapore, write to your pastor requesting the transfer, and send a copy to Vicar, St. George's Church, Minden Road, Singapore 248816. We will send you the necessary forms to complete. On completion and return of the forms, the Church office will arrange for the transfer.

• What if I am already a member of a church in my home country?

If you reside in Singapore on a non-permanent basis, we encourage you to register on the St. George's Electoral Roll, even if you remain a member of a church in the country from which you have come. Your membership of St. George's will not affect your membership of your home church. Most Christian churches are in communion with the Anglican Church.

The purpose of the Annual General Meeting

1. to receive the Annual Report from the Parochial Church Council (PCC) covering all aspects of the mission, ministry, finance and fabric of the church; and
 2. to appoint a PCC to take office for the ensuing 12 months
- In addition to the Reports received, matters may be proposed for the consideration of the incoming PCC.

The Parochial Church Council

consists of the *Vicar*, two *Churchwardens* – one appointed by the Vicar and one elected, 12 *elected members* and our two Diocesan Synod Representatives.

Those elected/appointed must be communicant members, and on the Electoral Roll, of the church. Membership of the PCC is an important ministry within the life of our church. Please pray that those elected to office will be "known to be full of the Spirit and of wisdom" (Acts 6:3), who will be committed to working together to seek the progress of the gospel and the building up of the church as the body of Christ, to His glory.

Powers and Duties of the PCC

The primary duty of the PCC is to cooperate with the Vicar in the initiation, conduct and development of church work both within the Parish and outside.

In particular, the PCC is responsible for

- the financial administration of the church
- the care and maintenance of church property

In addition to this, members of PCC have an opportunity and responsibility to work together with the Vicar and ministry staff to plan prayerfully and effectively for the building up of God's people and the promotion of His gospel through St. George's in Singapore and beyond.

Note: As members of the church governing board, you must be prepared to provide all government and bank required regulatory information.

PCC meetings are held monthly, currently on the last Thursday evening of the month.
