Job Purpose

St George's Church is seeking to appoint an Associate or Assistant Minister to work with the Vicar and the Church Council to evangelise, disciple and pastorally care for the people whom God brings into the reach of the church. The person will coordinate and lead various ministries and ministry initiatives.

Summary of Duties and Responsibilities

1. **Pastoral Oversight of one or two of the weekly congregations, including possibly planting a new congregation.**
2. **Regular preaching and involvement in Church Services.**
3. **Coordinate Evangelism Training and Discipleship Courses for church attendees**
4. **Baptism and Confirmation Preparation for parents of children and adults.**
5. **If appropriate gifting; work with the Church's Children's and Youth Directors in the spiritual care of families.**
6. **If appropriate gifting; Music Ministry Coordination across all Services.**
7. **If appropriate gifting; Involvement in developing the Church's digital strategy**
8. **Involvement in weekly Staff Meetings, monthly Prayer Meeting and writing reports for Church PCC**

Prerequisites

The successful applicant must be a committed evangelical Christian, a humble leader, pastorally warm, hardworking, team player, faithful to the gospel having already been fruitful in similar roles.

Essential requirements include:

1. Anglican ordination to the Diaconate (for an Assistant Minister) or Priesthood (for an Associate Minister)
2. High level of biblical and theological skill. Formal theological training at a minimum of Bachelor level
3. Demonstrated capability in mentoring, coaching and training leaders.
4. Demonstrated competence in pastoral care
5. Enjoy working in a team
6. Proficiency in English is vital

Working Conditions

Full Time (Preferred) or Part Time permanent Position.

2 years contract if not a Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident. Contract renewable upon satisfactory performance and the ability to gain a working Visa.
