Job Purpose

St George's Church is a growing, multicultural, Christ-centred body of believers, giving glory to God within the Anglican Diocese of Singapore. Our Mission is to a) present every person complete in Christ; b) to glorify Christ by living and proclaiming His gospel in Singapore and beyond and loving and caring for all in His name.

Our Vision is to;

DECLARE – proclaim and promote the gospel in Singapore and beyond;

PREPARE – equip one another for mission and ministry; and

CARE – reach out in love for one another and for our community, in the Name of Christ.

St George's Church is seeking to appoint an Anglican Auxiliary Priest, in a part time, 3 days/week role (20 hours), to work with the Vicar and the Church Council to disciple and pastorally care for the people whom God brings into the reach of the church. The person will coordinate and lead the adult discipleship ministries and ministry initiatives.

Summary of Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Coordinating, developing and multiplying the Church's Bible Study Groups (called Life Groups at St George's) including training and supporting the leaders as well as helping raise new leaders.**
- 2. Coordinating courses for evangelism and discipleship of adults (Online and/or In Person) and training and support of leaders for these courses.**
- 3. Regular involvement in the 8am and/or 10:15 am Sunday Church Services (which includes preaching, leading and presiding at Communion)**
- 4. Coordinating Baptism Preparation courses (4 times a year) for adults and parents of children.**
- 5. Coordinating Confirmation Preparation course (annual) for adults.**
- 6. Involvement in weekly Staff Meetings, monthly Prayer Meeting and writing monthly reports for the Parochial Church Council.**
- 7. Any other request from the Vicar.**

Prerequisites

The successful applicant must be a committed evangelical Christian, a humble leader, pastorally warm, hardworking, team player, faithful to the gospel and has already been fruitful in a similar role.

Essential requirements include:

1. Anglican ordination to the Priesthood and the person will be currently living in Singapore.
2. High level of biblical and theological skill. Formal theological training.

3. Demonstrated capability in mentoring, coaching and training leaders.
4. Demonstrated competence in pastoral care
5. Enjoy working in a team
6. Proficiency in English is vital

Working Conditions

Part Time.

In keeping with employment of retirees, a 1-year contract is offered. The contract is renewable upon satisfactory performance. Salary depends on training and experience.

CPF and some health coverage is included in the remuneration package.
